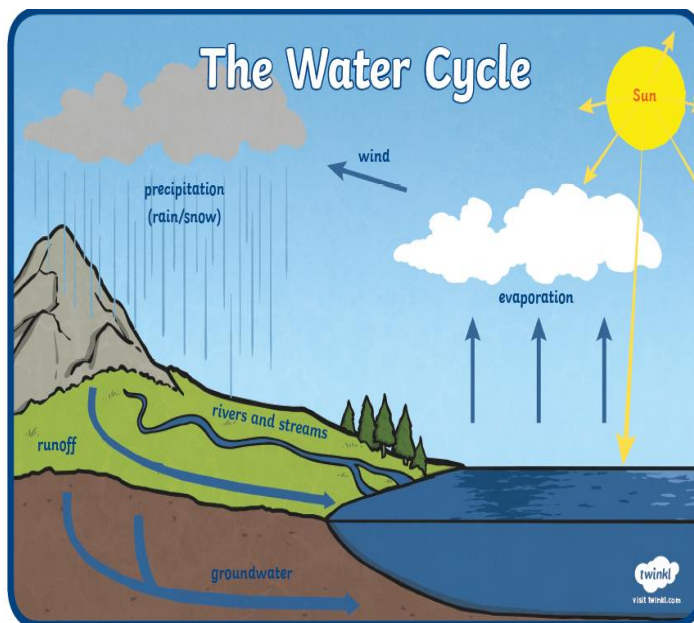
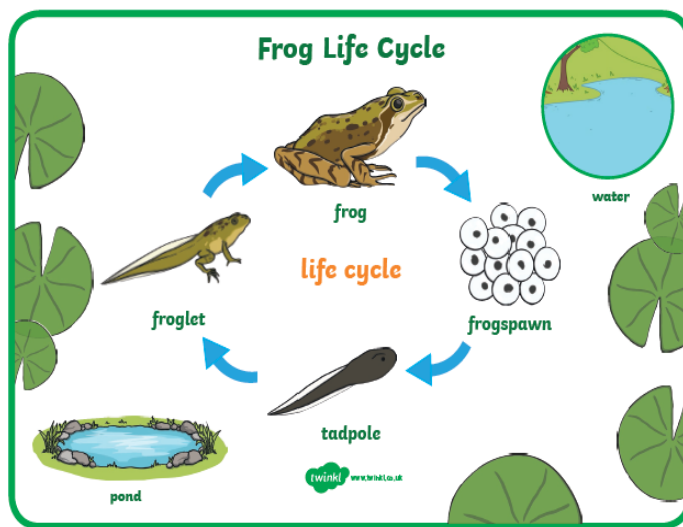

English:

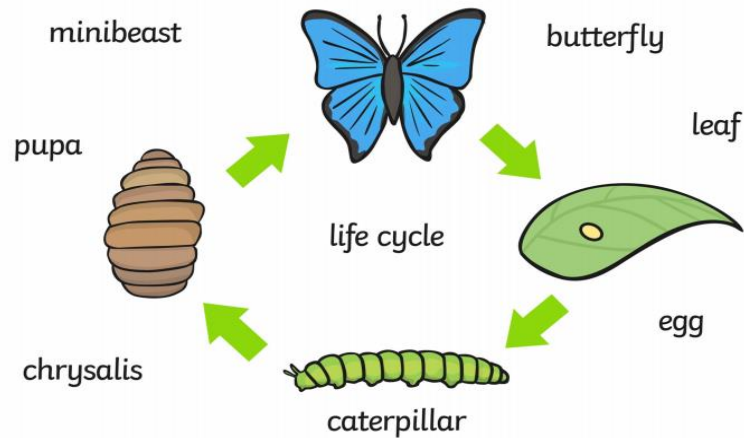
Please let your child write explanation texts at home to practise. They can write about: Frog lifecycle, the water cycle and the butterfly's lifecycle
